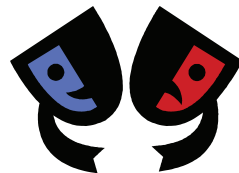

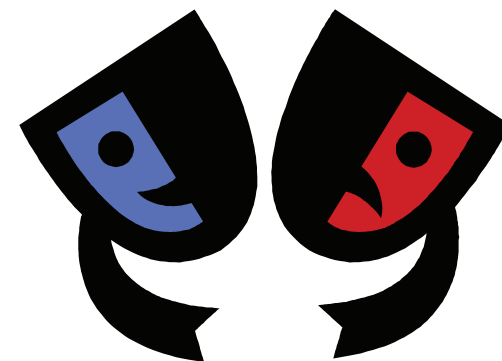

## Program Description

### Foundations for Musical Theatre

(Grades 3-10)

Designed for children or teens who have been involved in fewer than three major productions. Students are encouraged to repeat this program one or two years as desired.

Each student will attend separate modules in dance, drama, and voice during every session. Coaches will review fundamentals, and students will practice new concepts in small groups.

### Musical Theatre Intensive

(Grades 7-10)

Designed for teens who have significant musical theatre experience and /or have attended our Foundations Program for two years. Students will experience drama, dance, and voice at a faster pace with more advanced activities.

### Final Session

During our final session on July 31st, guests will be invited to share in our informal performance of works-in-progress!
